

# Tarrant Youth Camp 2010

Riverbend Retreat Center requests that you bring a ratio of 1 adult female leader\* to every 10 female youth and 1 adult male leader to every 10 male youth.

- Adult leaders are selected by each church and should be someone who is considered an adult by your church. This person should be, but does not have to be a college sophomore (about 20) or older. This is just a guideline, not a requirement. The youth minister counts towards this ratio.
- Example: You bring 17 girls and 12 guys that is 2 adult females and 1 male adult.

For the Tarrant Baptist Youth Camp this year we are requesting that each church bring one adult leader (see below) and one student leader\* for every 15 students you are bringing. The adult leader and the student leader will be teamed up by their own church to be family group leaders. Family group leaders will teach a bible study each day, lead a prayer time each night, and will be encouragers during recreation time.

- Adult leaders of a family group for our youth camp should not be the youth minister. The youth minister counts towards Riverbend requirements, but please do not count them as adult leaders for our youth camp. This is designed to help the youth minister hang out with their students.
- Student leaders are selected by each church, and should be someone who is between a finished 11<sup>th</sup> grader and college freshman. This should be someone from the youth group who is a leader, someone who can teach other youth, and someone who can share his/her faith to another youth with confidence.
- Example: You bring 30 youth, bring 2 adult and student leader pairs
